2 ...and to our Native Pollinators!

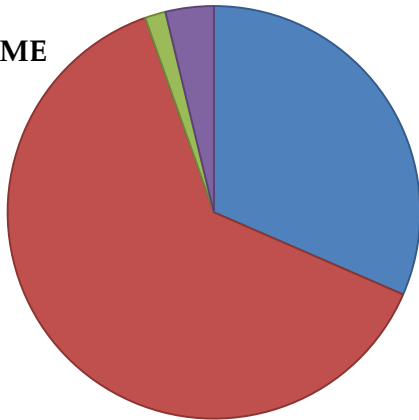
We landscaped around the new Welcome to Windsor sign to create a more inviting space that's attractive to our local pollinators.

We hosted an engaging afternoon of local music and photographs by 10 local photographers in our charming little chapel by the river.

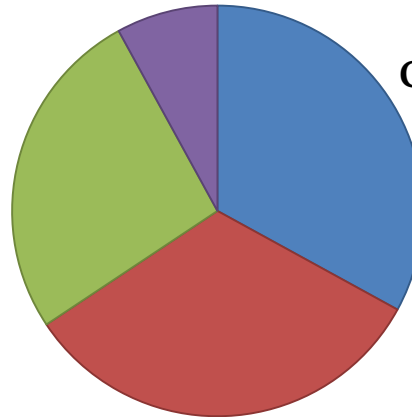

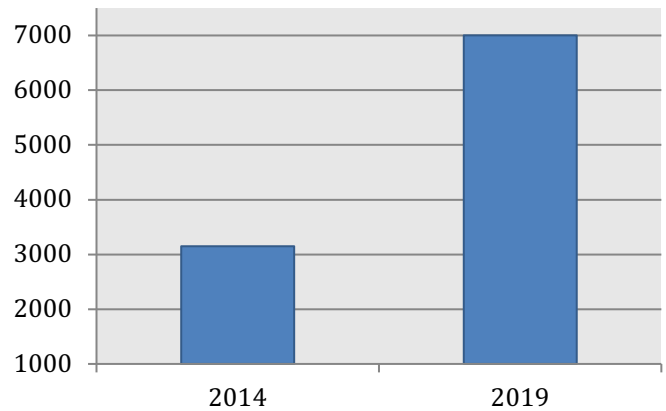

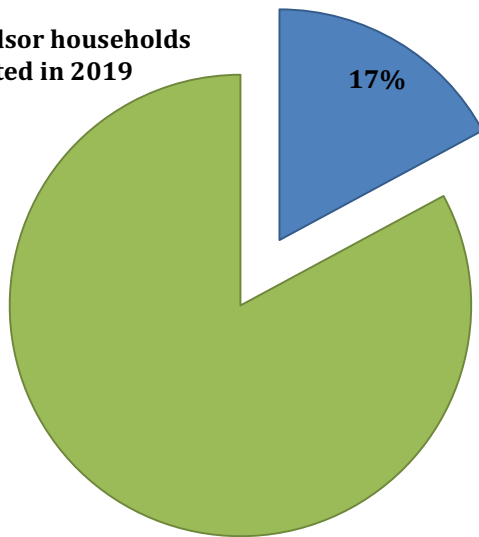

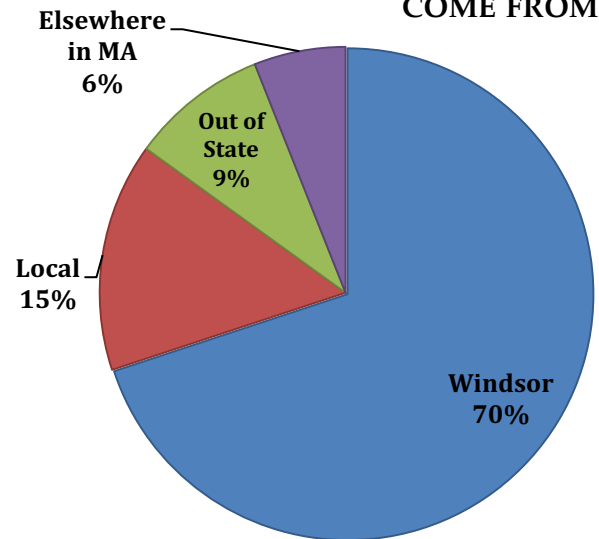
